WHAT IS PRACTICE COUNCIL?

The Practice Council exists to support Infinity Rehab's vision by identifying practice trends and challenges.

Members of the Practice Council are committed to promoting and executing high standards for therapy practice, increasing awareness in the field of specific trends, and inspiring peers to reach their highest potential.

There is a Practice Council for each discipline: physical therapy, occupational therapy and speech language pathology.

WHAT DOES PRACTICE COUNCIL DO?

- Refine best practices related to all aspects of each discipline
- Identify the need for and assist in developing discipline-specific training
- Provide a bridge of communication between practicing clinicians and corporate leadership
- Participate in discipline-specific special projects
- Evaluate emerging tools/practices and make recommendations for integration within Infinity
- Provide input into operational strategies that impact the practice of each discipline
- Practice Council members serve as a resource for field clinicians and a conduit for new ideas

WHO IS INVOLVED IN THE PRACTICE COUNCIL?

Highly engaged employees who desire greater involvement in impacting Infinity Rehab may be invited to join the Practice Council. Members must exhibit the following:

- A desire to create change and take action
- Model and influence clinical behaviors
- Expertise in the foundations and dynamics of the discipline practice
- Awareness of discipline-specific emerging trends
- Commitment to practice at the highest level
- Flexibility in thinking
- Willingness to express ideas and opinions



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WHAT ARE THE TIME COMMITMENTS AND DUTIES?

- The Practice Council meets every other month for 1.5 hours via video conferencing
- Projects may include: Testing clinical and people initiatives, assisting in the roll-out of Infinity initiatives, extending awareness and promoting participation of the Clinical Champions program, and updating discipline-specific policies and procedures
- Being a member requires commitment to participate in special projects between meetings
- Time spent toward Practice Council efforts are allocated to corporate time codes and does not impact facility productivity
